
## WHAT IS A THESIS, AND HOW DO I PREPARE FOR IT?


A THESIS is an independently-driven project that aims to contribute to our disciplinary discourse, by interrogating / critiquing / advancing / transforming ways that we might consider or understand architecture as a field of knowledge and design. A thesis reflects an individual student's specific disciplinary interests and curiosities, and is guided by a faculty committee.

DIRECTED RESEARCH is an intense semester of developing a thesis idea, through active research, review of precedents and relevant literature, and exploratory design activity. Directed Research will be design-focused research studio.




















